# Submission of Provisional Internship Permit Applications to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing

- Education Code T5 §80021.1 Requirements for Initial Issuance of the Provisional Internship Permit (Single Subject, Multiple Subject, and Special Education)
- California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) requires that every PIP request go through a public notice process at the local level and must be Board approved in a public meeting prior to the submission of the employing agency to CCTC
