# **Project Highlights:**

- Replace interior and exterior light fixtures with energy efficient light fixtures
- Work timeline is December 2024-June 2025
- 34 sites will receive work
- Average of 90% energy savings per light fixture
- Will receive SMUD energy retrofit rebate
- Expected project payback period of 8 years
- District negotiated 10-year material warranty (1-year typical)



### **Procurement Method**

- Government Code 4217 Energy Service Contract
- Post a notice of a public hearing to determine validity of using Government Code 4217
- Board holds a public hearing to determine whether the anticipated energy cost savings of proposed project has been reasonably established
