

Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators for the 2024-2025 School Year

- Title 5 of Education Code requires school districts to submit an annual Declaration of Need for qualified educators during a regularly scheduled Board meeting
- Provides flexibility as needed in order to fill positions in identified areas when educators meet the minimum qualifications to apply for permits through the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC)


School Years, 2020/2021, 2021/2022, 2022/2023, 2023/2024, and 2024/2025

Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators






Neighboring Districts 2024/2025 Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators



Due to the timing of the request, not all neighboring districts have submitted the Declaration of Need to their board. Therefore, we do not have the usual comparison available.




Limited Assignment Permit Estimate



Prop 28 seeks to augment funding for Art, Dance, and Theater programs, thereby enhancing our competitive edge against neighboring districts and positions.




Emergency Permit Estimate

Areas of need include English Language Authorizations (ELA), Transitional Kindergarten, Resource Specialists, Librarians, and some Limited Assignment Permits in Special Education, Single, and Multiple Subjects
