Overview of Facilities Request

- 2024, formation of 7-11 Committee to look at 4 properties
 - Fruitridge Elementary
 - Maple Elementary
 - C.P. Huntington Elementary
 - 24th & Florin (Old Automotive Dealership)
- Committee evaluated if these properties had an instructional purpose
- Properties chosen for lack of district program and cost to the General Fund



Board's Role in Property

- Prior to the sale, lease, or rental of any excess real property, the
 District Governing Board appoints a Committee to advise the Board
 regarding disposition of the excess property.
- The Board will take advisory recommendations into consideration in making final determinations regarding the excess property.
- The 7-11 Committee's recommendation is advisory only, and need not implemented by the Board.

Committee Process and Report Summary

- Application process and Board approval of 8-member Committee
- Four meetings total, governed by the Brown Act
- Committee work:
 - Review data to measure the likelihood of each property serving a School Purpose now, or in the future.
 - Develop a Committee Report for the Board of Education's consideration.
 - The report is advisory only and is nonbinding.
