Current Transportation Services

- General Education Bus Routes Grades K-6 for severe safety (walk path impeded by a railroad or interstate crossing and school closure for construction)
- Mandated Transportation Bus Routes PreK-22 years of age. (Special Education, Foster Youth, Unhoused/McKinney-Vento and 504 Health Plan)

Free Transit Authority Bus Passes

 All SCUSD students are eligible for a SacRT pass to ride all fixed-routes for free to travel to school, work, or events

Funding Transportation Reimbursement Calculations

 Projected calculations for reimbursement are based on the previous year's transportation expenses

2024-2025 Transportation Allowance for Home-to-School Transportation

- The 2022-2023 State Budget Act included a transportation allowance for Home-to-School (HTS) transportation for eligible local educational agencies (LEAs).
- Education Code Sections 39800.1 and 41850.1 states that eligible local educational agencies (LEA) transportation allowances will be "equal to 60%" of the HTS transportation expenditures reported by the school district for the prior year (2023-2024).
- Note that this allowance will be reduced by the amount of the LEA's Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) transportation add-on.
- The District's estimated allowance is \$8.3M.
