<u>Longevity Steps</u>: Commencing with the 2023-24 school year, UPE members will be eligible for longevity steps at the following years as reflected on the salary schedule attached hereto:

- Year 10 2% of employee's base salary
- Year 14 4% of employee's base salary
- Year 17 6% of employee's base salary
- Year 20 8% of employee's base salary
- Year 25 10% of employee's base salary

Unit members employed on or after July 1, 2017 on a twelve (12) month work calendar will work 223 days a year for the 2017-18 school year and thereafter with no vacation days.

Longevity Increments: Effective July 1, 2023, Longevity steps are paid as follows:

- 10 years 2% of employee's base salary
- 14 years 4% of employee's base salary
- 17 years 6% of employee's base salary
- 20 years 8% of employee's base salary
- 25 years 10% of employee's base salary

An annual stipend of \$1,745 is added for the earned doctorate and is prorated if for less than a full year which will end on 2/28/2018. Effective 3/1/2018, the earned doctorate annual stipend will increase to \$3,000 and is prorated for less than a full year.
