**Background/Rationale**: Culture & Climate is an Academic Priority for SCUSD, and our work in this area continues to evolve from a focus on Social Emotional Learning to a more comprehensive framework centered on Culture and Climate. This framework is designed to create safe, inclusive learning environments for both students and adults.

To achieve this, we aim to critically examine our policies and practices through an Anti-Bias/Anti-Racist/Trauma-Informed lens, while committing to Culturally and Linguistically Responsive/Sustaining Pedagogy. We leverage evidence-based standards, strategies and tools to ensure that our educational practices promote equity and honor the cultural and linguistic backgrounds of our community.

The Culture & Climate Framework rests on three pillars:

- Knowledge and Love of Self
- Solidarity
- Collective Determination

These pillars are sustained and supported by Social Justice Standards, Compassionate Dialogue/RIR, Trauma Informed Principles & Practices, and Transformational SEL.

The purpose of this presentation is to provide an overview of the resources developed and curated by the Culture & Climate team. These resources are tailored to support staff in fostering environments that reflect our shared commitment to anti-racism, equity, inclusivity, and social justice.
